The Award is available for “**STUDENT**” members of the MWOA to encourage professional development and opportunities in participating in a special project and learn more about the benefits of additives such as “PolyCom Stabilising Aid” which can improve the effectiveness of road based materials.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

The Scholarship funding allocation is up to **\$2,500**. The Scholarship granted will reflect the quantity and quality of applications within the Scholarship allocation which are determined by the MWOA Board and approved by Earthco Projects. Applications for the Scholarship are to be addressed to the CEO of the MWOA, attention Stephen M Robertson.

The nominated councils to assist with this project will be Alpine Shire Council, and West Wimmera Shire Council. One or both of these councils can be chosen to investigate, depending on applicant’s location.

Announcement of successful applicant will announced at the National Works & Engineering Conference, 26th 27th September 2013, and also notified in writing from the CEO of the MWOA.

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Applications should include:

- Work history, current position and responsibilities.
- Benefits to personal development, council and industry.
- Letter of support from council.
- MWOA Student Member (Membership is free for current students doing Certificate III)

Commitments may include:

- Availability of a paper presentation to MWOA General or Regional Meeting 2013/2014.
- Availability of the paper presentation to be listed on the MWOA web site.

Note: If the Award allocation is not enough to cover costs etc, it is reasonable and appropriate for your council to assist with any shortfall.

50% Payment up front with the remaining 50% paid on completion of your presentation.
